By promptly reporting these members you are spreading the spirit of love and caring and allowing all Auxiliaries and Grands the ability to send cards.

Please be sure to clarify if the person in need is ill or has passed and be sure to send information on where to send the cards.

Please submit these in a timely manner and be sure to PRINT clearly all information.

Please complete and submit the monthly Chaplain report either to the Grand Chaplain if in a Grand or directly to the Supreme Chaplain by the **5**th **of the month.** Even if you have nothing to report, please send a monthly report each month. The Grand Chaplains will report to Supreme by the **15**th **of each month.**

Please use the back of the report to prepare a short summary of your activities during the month and retain a copy for your files.

The Supreme Chaplain needs to be immediately notified of the illness or death of a Supreme MOC/MOCA officer, death of a Past Supreme Commander or Past Supreme President, Grand Commander, or President with any available details.

Cheering up our MOC and MOCA family depends on all chaplains submitting complete information to all levels in a timely manner.
