

Things you might not know...

The Military Order of the Cootie (MOC) was established on September 17, 1920, in Washington DC by Fred C. Madden and F.L. Gransbury

The name "Cootie" is in reference to the lice that plagued service members in WWI. "Cooties" were credited with keeping service members alive by forcing them to keep their heads down while they scratched the vile vermin. Hence the reference to our meeting being called a "SCRATCH".

The first MOC newsletter was called the "Cootie Tickle"

The first three(3) Leaders of the MOC were called "Supreme Seam Squirrels"

The MOC became a part of the VFW on Saturday, September 24, 1923

The Trek to the Tomb of the Unknowns, Arlington National Cemetery, was first inaugurated in 1934 by TNT Pup Tent. Known as "Tomb Trek"

The program of "Keep 'Em Smiling in Beds of White" was inaugurated during the outbreak of World War II
